

RECORD OF FIRE AND TORNADO DRILLS

Foster homes must do fire and tornado drills at least twice per year **and** within 24 hours of the placement of a new foster child. Emergency drills should be held more often if anyone in the home needs more practice to become familiar with the procedure. Foster parents must turn this form into our office by June 30 and December 31 each year **and** with the first monthly reports for new children. Prospective foster parents need to do fire and tornado drills before certification and give CFS a copy of this form for your file.
